CAP OPERATIONAL MISSIONS

CAPR 60-3, 10 May 2001 is supplemented as follows:

1. This supplement is **interim** guidance to CAPR 60-3 pending final approval from National Headquarters
2. Annotate the following changes to CAPR 60-3:
 - 2-2.a. 3) Added: Operational specialty ratings will be annotated on the LA CAP Form 101 (Attachment 2). LA Wing members will substitute LA CAP Form 101 (LA CAPF101) for all references to CAP Form 101 in this regulation.
 - 2-2.d.1) Added: General ES cards will only be issued by the LA Wing Emergency Services data officer. All training will be documented in the squadron on the applicable CAPF-101T. When training is completed, requests for an LA CAPF 101 card will be submitted to the LA Wing ES data officer on an LA Form 603 (Attachment 1). Upon receipt of an LA Form 603, the wing ES data officer will issue a LA CAPF 101 to the individual.
 - 2-2.d.2) Added: Application for an LA CAPF 101(Attachment 2) will be submitted on an LA CAPF 603 by the individual to the unit commander no later than 60 days prior to the expiration of their current LA CAPF 101. When signing the LA CAPF 603, the unit commander will ensure the individual is qualified in that specialty, including all follow-on training, IAW the applicable regulations. The individual's personnel folder will have the applicable CAPR 60-4, Volume II CAPF-101T for each specialty the individual is qualified in. Cert No is the certificate number from the completed national tests for that specialty. If there are no additional national tests required, this block will be marked N/A or lined through.
 - 2-3.a.1) Added: Additionally, LA Wing members must complete the ES communications requirements prior to being issued a General ES LA CAPF101 because the LA CAPF101 incorporates the CAP radio operations permit, into the basic 101 card.
 - 2-4.c. Added to end of paragraph: LA CAPF 101 application will be made on a LA CAPF 603 (Attachment 1).
 - 2-4.c.1) Added: LA CAP Form 101 cards remain valid through the last day of the 24th month from the date of issue. Individual specialty ratings will remain valid through the last day of the 24th month from the date of last completion or to the expiration of the LA CAPF 101, whichever is sooner. Currency updates will be made to the wing ES database via the CAPF 103 after any SAR, SAREX, or CN mission. Incident Commanders after each mission, in addition to the normal wing paperwork copies, will verify the member has worked in the specialty signed for on the CAPF 103. They will then sign and send a copy of each CAPF 103 to the wing ES data officer. Expiration of FAA or CAP pilot requirements will suspend CAP pilot specialties until the requirements are complete. These will be updated via the LA Form 60 process and then shown on the LA CAPF 101.
 - 2-4.c.2) Added: When requesting a new LA CAPF 101 or adding specialties to an existing LA CAPF 101 card, members will submit a completed LA CAPF 603 along with supporting documentation (CAPF-101T) to the unit commander. The unit commander will validate entries on the LA CAPF 603 against the CAPF-101T and forward only the signed LA CAPF 603 to Wing or directly to the Wing ES data officer. In the General ES Training Section of the LA CAPF 603, the member will place the month and year of either their most recent training in those areas. In the LA CAPF 603 Specialty Qualifications Section, the member will place the month and year of the last time those specialty duties were completed in an actual / exercise SAR or CN mission.
